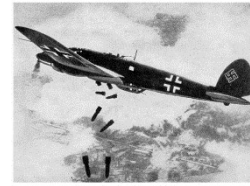
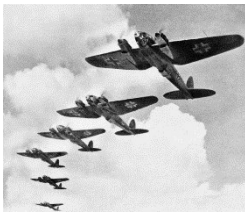


Year 9 History Project - due in first week after Easter
